MEETING MINUTES

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER, AFTER WHICH REVEREND D. CONE GAVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS R. CULPEPPER, C. ELSBERRY, T. STANLEY, R. WEBB, C. HENDERSON. EMPLOYEES L. BROWN, J. HENDLEY, R. WARREN, B. SMITH WERE ALSO PRESENT. VISITORS INCLUDED L. HENDLEY, D. BROWN, J. BENJAMIN AND K. DIXON.

THE MAYOR REQUESTED EACH OF THE COUNCIL MEMEBERS READ THE MARCH MEETING MINUTES. C. ELSBERRY MADE A MOTION THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED. R. WEBB SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

K. DIXON FROM WIA ONE STOP GAVE A PRESENTATION TO THE COUNCIL. HE DISCUSSED THE 4 PROGRAMS THAT ONE STOP HAS. THE FIRST IS TO PROVIDE AN ACCESS POINT WITH A COMPUTER TO HELP CITIZENS LOOK FOR A JOB, TRAINING OR SCHOOL. WIA ALSO ASSIST THOSE LOOKING TO GO BACK TO SCHOOL, AND HELPS COVER EXPENSES. WIA ALSO HELPS WITH ON THE JOB TRAINING. AND LASTLY HAS A YOUTH PROGRAM TO HELP CHILDREN FIND JOBS AND ALSO AIDS WITH CHILDREN WHO ARE STRUGGLING IN SCHOOL.
