ABBEVILLE CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER, AFTER WHICH REVEREND J. OWENS GAVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS R. CULPEPPER, C. ELSBERRY, C. HENDERSON, M.COOK, T. STANLEY, R. WEBB. EMPLOYEES PRESENT WERE B. SMITH, J. HENDLEY, R. HENDERSON, R. WARREN. VISITORS WERE L. HENDLEY.

THE MAYOR REQUESTED THAT EACH OF THE COUNCIL MEMEBERS REVIEW THE MAY MEETING MINUTES. R. CULPEPPER MADE A MOTION THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED. M. COOK SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT HE WAS INTERESTED IN SECURING A CONTRACT WITH MOBILE COMPUTER CLINIC FOR THE CITY'S COMPUTERS. THE CONTRACT WOULD COST \$125.00 PER MONTH. COUNCIL MEMBERS R. CULPEPPER AND M. COOK SUGGESTED GETTING QUOTES FROM OTHERS TO COMPARE PRICES.

T. STANLEY STATED THAT L. BROWN WOULD LIKE TO BRING IT TO THE COUNCILS ATTENTION THAT ENGINE #2 IS 40 YEARS OLD AND WOULD LIKE TO LOOK INTO PURCHASING SOMETHING NEWER TO HANDLE THE CALLS THAT ARE RECEIVED OUT IN THE COUNTY.

C. ELSBERRY ASKED THAT A "SLOW CHILDREN PLAYING" SIGN BE PUT UP ON CHURCH STREET.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT THE CITY WOULD BE PERFORMING A SMOKE TEST ON THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM DURING THE WEEK OF JULY 7, TO DETERMINE IF THERE WERE LEAKS IN THE SEWER SYSTEM.

POLICE CHIEF J. HENDLEY GAVE THE POLICE REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF MAY. CHIEF HENDLEY STATED THAT HE HAD 8 APPLICANTS FOR THE OPEN POSITION BUT THAT NONE WERE CERTIFIED. CHIEF HENDLEY STATED THAT HE HAS 4 THAT HE AND THE MAYOR WILL INTERVIEW AND PLANS TO SEND 2 APPLICANTS TO THE POLICE ACADEMY.

WITH NO FUTHER BUSINESS C. HENDERSON MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN THE MEETING, R. WEBB SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED AYE.
