ABBEVILLE CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER, AFTER WHICH MIKE COOK GAVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS C. ELSBERRY, M.COOK, T. STANLEY, R. WEBB. EMPLOYEES PRESENT WERE B. SMITH, J. HENDLEY, AND R. HENDERSON. VISITORS WERE L. HENDLEY.

THE MAYOR REQUESTED THAT EACH OF THE COUNCIL MEMEBERS REVIEW THE JUNE MEETING MINUTES. R. CULPEPPER MADE A MOTION THAT THE MINUTES BE APPROVED. R. WEBB SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

RUSTY AND HARRY SMITH OF ABBEVILLE COMMISSIONING PRESENT THE COUNCIL WITH A DESIGN AND DRAWING FOR THE OLD CITY HALL BUILDING. THE RENOVATION WILL BE DONE IN THREE PHASES. THE FIRST PHASE WILL MAKE THE BUILDING USEABLE WITH A PROJECTED COST OF \$33,372.00. THE SECOND PHASE WILL FEATURE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE KITCHEN, OFFICES AND HALLWAYS WITH A COST OF \$24,526.00. THE THIRD PHASE CONSIST OF THE RENOVATION OF THE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDING WITH A PROJECTED COST OF \$16, 277.00. GIVING THE TOTAL PROJECT COST ESTIMATED AT \$74195.00. WITH \$12,500.00 DUE TO ABBEVILLE COMISSION. R. CULPEPPER MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT ABBEVILLE COMMISSION'S DESIGN AND DRAWING AND T. STANLEY SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR ESTES MADE MENTION THAT WILCOX STATE PRISON COULD FURNISH A PRISON CONSTRUCTION CREW TO HELP CUT THE COST OF THE CONSTRUCTION.

C. ELSBERRY STATED THAT THE CITY IS HOSTING A MOVIE NIGHT. A SCREEN WILL BE SET UP IN THE PARK AND FOOD VENDORS WILL BE PRESENT WITH POPCORN AND SNACKS.

CHIEF HENDLEY GAVE THE POLICE REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE.

MAYOR ESTES PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH FOUR ORDINANCES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. THE ORDINANCES WERE FOR SIMPLE ASSAULT, SIMPLE BATTERY, AFFRAY, OBSTRUCTION OR HINDERING LAW ENFORCEMENT. THIS WAS THE FIRST READING FOR THE ORDINANCES.

MAYOR ESTES READ A RESIGNATION LETTER FOR MUNICIPLE JUDGE DORSEY EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2014. MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT MAGISTRATE JUDGE SHAWN RHODES HAS AGREED TO FILL THE POSITION OF MUNICIPLE JUDGE FOR THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE. C. ELSBERRY MADE A MOTION TO APPOINT S. RHODES MUNICIPLE JUDGE. R CULPEPPER SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR ESTES PRESENTED THE COUNCIL WITH MOBILE COMPUTER CLINIC MAINTENANCE CONTRACT. THE CONTRACT WILL BE GOOD FOR 12 MONTHS AT THE COST OF \$1,500. MIKE COOK MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MAINTENANCE CONTRACT WITH MOBILE COMPTER CLINIC. C. ELSBERRY SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THE VIETNAM TRAVELING WALL WILL BE IN ASBURN ON SEPTEMBER 5, 2014. THE CITY IS ASKING FOR DONATIONS AND THE MAYOR MADE A RECOMMENDATION THAT THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE DONATE \$300. M. COOK MADE A MOTION. R. CULPEPPER SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

WITH NO FURTHER BUSINESS M. COOK MADE A MOTION THE MEETING BE ADJOURNED. R. CULPEPPER
SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.
