ABBEVILLE CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING TO ORDER AFTERWHICH HE ASKED REVEREND JOHN CALHOUN TO GIVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS C. ELSBERRY, M.COOK, T. STANLEY, R. CULPEPPER, C. HENDERSON. EMPLOYEES PRESENT WERE B. SMITH, R. WARREN, R. HENDERSON W. BASS AND Z. TAYLOR. VISITORS WERE L. HENDLEY, R. SMITH AND H. SMITH.

AFTER A DISCUSSION OF THE SEPTEMBER MEETING MINUTES C. HENDERSON MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. M. COOK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED AYE.

ABBEVILLE COMMISSIONING GAVE COPY OF BIDS FOR HVAC, WIRING AND PLUMBING TO ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. AFTER MUCH DISCUSSION COUNCIL DECIDED TO GO WITH THE LOWEST BIDDER ON EACH BID. M.COOK MADE A MOTION, R. CULPEPPER SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR PRO TEM ELSBERRY READ THE SECOND READING FOR THE DOG ORDINANCE FOR FEES. M. COOK MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT, R. CULPEPPER SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

CAPTAIN BASS GAVE THE MONTHLY POLICE REPORT. CAPTAIN BASS ALSO STATED THAT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT CADETS HAD GRADUATED FOR THE POLICE ACADEMY AT ABAC. CAPTAIN BASS GAVE EACH COUNCIL MEMBER A COPY OF AN UPDATED FINES LIST THAT INCLUDED SOME CHANGES TO THE FINES LIST. CAPTAIN BASS STATED THAT JUDGE RHODES HAD APPROVED THE INCREASE IN FINES. R. CULPEPPER MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE INCREASE IN FINES, C. HENDERSON SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.
