

**NOVEMBER 13, 2014**

**ABBEVILLE CITY COUNCIL**

**MEETING MINUTES**

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING TO ORDER AFTERWHICH HE ASKED REVEREND BOBBY DAVIS TO GIVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS C. ELSBERRY, M.COOK, T. STANLEY, R. WEBB. EMPLOYEES PRESENT WERE B. SMITH, R. HENDERSON, L. BROWN AND J. HENDLEY. VISITORS WERE L. HENDLEY.

AFTER A DISCUSSON OF THE OCTOBER MEETING MINUTES C. HENDERSON MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. R. WEBB SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED AYE.

CHIEF HENDLEY GAVE THE MONTHLY POLICE REPORT. THE CHIEF ALSO STATED THAT HE HAD RECEIVED A RESIGNATION FROM CAPTAIN BASS.

THE MAYOR STATED THAT THE CITY OF ABBEVILLE WAS INTERESTING IN APPLYING FOR A CDBG GRANT FOR A NEW WELL. IN ORDER TO APPLY FOR THE GRANT THE CITY MUST ADOPT A RESOLUTION. CLERK BETH SMITH READ THE RESOULTION. THE MAYOR PASSED TO THE COUNCIL MEMBERS 5 QUALIFICATIONS FROM ENGINEERING FIRMS. EACH OF THE QUALIFICATION PACKAGES WERE READ BY THE COUNCIL. AFTER DISCUSSIONS WERE MADE C. ELSBERRY MADE A MOTION TO ADOPT THE RESOULTION AND USE ENGINEERS CARTER AND SLOOPE. T. STANLEY SECONDED THE MOTION AND ALL VOTED AYE.
