ABBEVILLE CITY COUNCIL

MEETING MINUTES

MAYOR ESTES CALLED THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING TO ORDER AFTERWHICH HE ASKED M. COOK TO GIVE THE INVOCATION.

PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMEBERS C. ELSBERRY, M.COOK, T. STANLEY, R. WEBB, C. HENDERSON, R. CULPEPPER. EMPLOYEES PRESENT WERE B. SMITH, L. BROWN, W. BASS AND J. HENDLEY.

AFTER A DISCUSSION OF THE NOVEMBER MEETING MINUTES C. ELSBERRY MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. T. STANLEY SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED AYE.

CHIEF HENDLEY GAVE THE MONTHLY POLICE REPORT.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT THE CITY HAS APPLIED FOR A CREDIT CARD THROUGH WILCOX COUNTY STATE BANK. THE MAYOR STATED THAT CITY CLERK VALERIE "BETH" SMITH WOULD BE THE AUTHORIZED SIGNER FOR THE CITY. M. COOK MADE A MOTION FOR THE CLERK TO BE THE SIGNER. R. WEBB SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT CITY ATTORNEY T. SAYWER HAD LOOKED OVER THE ORIGINAL DOG ORDINANCE AND FOUND SOME CHANGES THAT NEEDED TO BE MADE. ALL OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS WERE GIVEN A COPY OF THE UPDATED ORDINANCE TO READ. THIS WAS THE FIRST READING OF THE ORDINANCE.

MAYOR ESTES STATED THAT THE CITY WISHED TO PURSUE OPENING ABBEVILLE PRIMARY CARE. THE MAYOR STATED THAT THE CITY NEEDED ABOUT \$35,000 IN EQUIPMENT TO GET THE OFFICE UP AND RUNNING. DR. TERRY WOGAN IS INTERESTED IN THE POSITION. HE WOULD REQUIRE AN LPN AND AN OFFICE MANAGER AND AN NP. C. ELSBERRY MADE A MOTION TO GO AHEAD AND START TO WORK ON THE DOCTOR'S OFFICE. C. HENDERSON SECONDED. ALL VOTED AYE.

WITH NO FURTHER BUSINESS, A MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY C. HENDERSON WITH M. COOK SECONDING THE MOTION. ALL VOTED AYE.
